

**Votive Capital and Church of each course, a Prayer to Our Lady,
in Memory of the Great Pontiff: "Karol Wojtyla."**

***The route runs between the towns of Alba, Roddi, Verduno, La Morra,
Vergne, Novello, Monforte, Serralunga, Gallo and S. Rosalia.***

***SOME POINTS OF PRAYER CHURCH IS UNKNOWN AND OLD UPRIGHT CAPITAL VOTIVE
GRACES RECEIVED IN MEMORY OF A TIME THAT WERE***

**ALBA (San Cassiano) – Roddi - Verduno - village CASTAGNI -
La Morra - Vergne - Novello - Monforte -
SAINT Giuseppe - Valle di Perno - Castelletto -
Gallo Grinzane - S. Rosalia - Alba (San Cassiano).**

Starting from the parking lot of the pool in San Cassiano, we head towards the village of Gallo Grinzane / Barolo, made three hundred meters turn right into Low Road.

Before asphalt and gravel in after we reach a crossroads turn left towards Roddi.

Become the paved road will take us on the highway where we turn right.

Continue for one hundred meters to "Enomotel" where we turn left into the street municipal to country Verduno and loc. Roccabella.

Continuing Verduno are on our left the church of "S. MARIA del Cammino".
We continue, still on the road to Verduno: we find to our left a pier dedicated to St. Mary built by the family Musso Sebastiano.

Always continue to Verduno.

At the next junction turn right towards Roddi.

After the climb we take the detour to the left (180 degrees) for the locality Toetto.
We find after a few meters pylon in neglect:
The image you see still seems to have been dedicated to the Sacred Heart.

Go ahead and after three hundred meters turn left into gravel.
Following the dirt road through the vineyards to get in asphalt road:
turn left onto the road steeply uphill.

Without the descent you arrive at the church of S. MARY OF CARMELO.
We continue right and take the first right onto paved road with sign: Cascina Fava.

At the next crossroads we turn left, which is unpaved.
Go ahead and reached the paved county road turn uphill for Verduno.
Here you can see the new hospital under construction in Alba-Bra.

At the end of the last climb we left towards the parish church.

Take the left lane to get into "Borgna square" where we find the parish church dedicated to St. Michael Church built in 1708.

Continuing on the main street of the village, slightly downhill the intersection with a roundabout.

Continue straight towards Rivalta.

Facts are 100 meters to our left a narrow paved and the chapel dedicated to Santa Maria (road Madonnina), we take to get into the gravel, the town of La Morra ".

After the first climb we arrive at the Cantina Bel Colle, (village Castagni).

Go ahead and come to the province, turn right and after 500 meters uphill, turn left onto paved road (yellow house).

After 500 meters to our left we see the church dedicated to Our Lady of Loreto. Continuing always right, dirt road uphill to La Morra.

Arriving at the provincial turning left towards the village.

Near the first round, we find an old pier, now restored.

Continue straight to the country.

Reached the country at the crossroads (fountain and toilets opposite the intersection) turn right towards Barolo.

After about 800 meters, turn right onto GREAT REPEATERS Borgata and Hell. Via Fontane.

At the start of the road on the left is the church dedicated to Saint BRIGIDA built by a Genesio in 1874 and then renovated in 1982.

At the next intersection you avoid going on to Berri village turning left.

Climb to the Bric Tooth, scenic views, only spoiled by the presence of many repeaters. The BRIC is also a chapel and a lighthouse votive Alpini.

The road then begins to decline becoming fully natural. Follow the main direction guided by the signs of yellow wood "Gir d'le Masche", (masks around).

At some point need to abandon the dirt road along a track marked down the slope.

A little further attention to turn right to bypass the farmhouse lawn Bergeisa.

Beyond that the trail becomes a dirt road by which we aim to Vergne.

By not stopping at houses Vaira cross the village and then reached a crossroads we turn left and then right at reaching the square of the Vine and Wine.

Follow the dirt road next to the company Vajra before turning right.

Follow the signs for the **masks around** along a path through a hazelnut and reaches a crossroads: it leaves the sign to the left Barolo turn instead to the Novello.

Continue straight ahead until you reach the paved road on the left there will Ciocchini reach the township.

Here we go right (enter a private courtyard!) And after a few meters, turn left along a gravel cart.

After a short but tough dirt incline, continue for 50 meters and then turn left. Following the trail becomes dirt, point to the obvious Cemetery Novello.

In correspondence of a house are on the right, faces left a trail that goes back to the pharmacy (the yellow building more recognizable 'above).

Cross SP58, turns right onto gravel yard, follow the road right towards Novello, we find the remains of the chapel of St. Rocco, using the shell in 1884 during the cholera epidemic, such as hospital.

At the Church of St. LUCIA is down to the left of 180 degrees.

We always follow the track until 'at some point take a dirt road that goes uphill on the right side of a small cottage (white markings and red signs Monforte).

Little more 'before you leave for the continuation Monforte on the left and crossing a meadow you come to the SP163.

Here we avoid following the asphalt path that runs parallel to the road which we find most 'forward.

Once on the road Barolo / Monforte Panarole the village, turn right towards Monforte. Without 50 meters turn left onto the gravel road on your right.

Immediately on the right of the gravel road, and we take a dirt road along a vineyard in steep ascent to the top of the hill.

At the top of the road, became paved, continue straight until you reach the province. Here we find the church of the Nativity 'S. Maria del 15/18 century. Turn left toward Monforte.

At the end of the square of Monforte turn left into the road to Roddino.

At the end of the descent we find to our right, a shrine dedicated to the Madonna del Ponte.

Continue until you find on our left the road that will take us up to St. Joseph Church.

Continue rights before a slight descent and then a steep descent to the valley below. arrived at the fork end down the paved road going right now paved. The road becomes dirt.

After the way the valley floor, there, before joining the provincial on our right a pillar dedicated to Our Lady S. MARIA. Turn right on paved road towards Gallo.

This brings us to the state for Serralunga and turn left. At roundabout turn right there in the direction Gallo Grinzane. After 500 meters on your right, the pier dedicated to St. MARIA. The pylon was built by the fam. Cagnasso brothers in 1967.

Past the village of Gallo Grinzane, are on the right, a paved road (road Baresani) for the village Santa Rosalia.

Going into the first uphill and then a steep climb, you arrive at. It goes right where we left our beautiful pylon built with Russian soil forever dedicated to the Madonna. (Fountain).

Continue straight on floor, paved road.

At the end of the paved road, where the houses end, we find a path barely visible in the grass down.

continuing straight there is a dirt road and then gravel.

reach down to the municipal Alba / Santa Rosalia.

Arrived in the street turn left downhill towards Alba.

At first major intersection (no stop) turn left into the street Cauda, then at the end of the road reached the round of course Piave turn left towards San Cassiano.

TOTAL km of route: 48
